NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by :
 - The "rules" as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020.
 - The current valid class rules of the International Laser Radial Class.
 - The National Prescriptions 2017-2020 and the 2019 Prescription of the HSF racing programme.
 - This Notice of Race.
 - The Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2 In RRS 61.1 is added: A boat intending to lodge a protest must inform the RC her intention to protest and the number of the protested immediately after finish.
- 1.3 If there is a conflict between languages, the English text will take precedence.
- 1.4 If there is a conflict between the NoR and the SIs, the SIs instructions will take precedence (Change of RRS 63.7).

2. ADVERTISEMENT

- 2.1 This Regatta is classified as Category C concerning World Sailing Rule 20.
- 2.2 Boats having individual advertisement should have the approval of the Hellenic Sailing Federation or their relevant National Authority.
- 2.3 Copy of this approval should be provided to the Regatta Office.







3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 Eligible competitors for the National Championship shall be athletes that have valid HSF Sailor Identification Card and Health Condition Card. Foreign nationals competing in the Open Championship must provide their National's Authority ID card.
- 3.2 Sailing Clubs shall send with email the following documents:
 - ➤ HSF Sailor Identification Card & Health Condition Card for Greek nationals. Their national authority ID card for foreign nationals.
 - Boats Insurance Certificates.
 - Rib Insurance Certificate.
 - Coach Identification Card or Coach Professional Qualification Document.
 - Speedboat License.
- 3.3 Sailing Clubs shall file their application form until 14/06/2019 in the following email: nokalamakiou@gmail.com
- 3.4 A Sailing Club's application will be accepted only if they have a rescue boat and a coach, who's name should be stated inside the application form.
- 3.5 The Championships are open to all nations, but only sailors from Greece may compete for the Greek National title.
- 3.6 Entry fee is set to 20,00 €.

- 5.1 The last day of the Event no warning signal will be given after 16:55.
- 5.2 No more than 3 races will be sailed each day.
- 5.3 9 Races has been scheduled to be sailed.







6. EQUIPMENT AND MEASUREMENT CHECKS

6.1 A boat or equipment may be inspected at any time for compliance with the class rules and sailing instructions. On the water, a boat can be instructed by a Technical or Race Committee member to proceed immediately to a designated area for inspection.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

7.1 Sailing Instructions will be available at the Regatta Office at 26/06/2019.

8. COURSE AREA

8.1 The races will be sailed outside of the Alimos Marina.

9. COURSES

9.1 Attachment A describes the course, and the marks and approx. angles.

10. PENALTY SYSTEM

10.1 Appendix P of the RRS 2017-2020 shall apply.

11. SCORING

- 11.1 RRS Appendix A will apply. Three races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 11.2 When 4 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

12. SUPPORT BOATS

- 12.1 Support Boats shall be filed at the Regatta Office. Support Boat's Drivers shall be responsible for their movements, always wear quick stop which is connected at the engine switch and have a valid Speedboat License.
- 12.2 Right of Entry in the National Championship will only have coaches that have a Coach Professional Qualification Document and that they have not lapsed into any disciplinary offense or used any restricted substances.
- 12.2 Each Sailing Club shall have a maximum of 10 athletes per coach and a rescue boat.

13. PRIZES

13.1 Prizes will be given to the 1st three winners of each division.







14. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

14.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

15. INSURANCE

- 15.1 Each support boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of € 540.000 per event or the equivalent.
- 15.2 All competitor boats shall have insurance coverage according to WS.
