

**DISTRICT 14 CHAMPIONSHIP (OPEN)
(ATHENS EUROLYMP WEEK 2011)
MARINA DELTA FALIROU
21 – 25 MARCH 2011**

NOTICE OF RACE

1. Rules

The Regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS) and the rules of the International Star Class Yacht Racing Association (STCR). The Organizing Authority is ISCYRA District 14 in conjunction with the International Star Class Yacht Racing Association (ISCYRA). The host fleet is Hellenic Sailing Federation, Greece.

- 1.1 Decisions of the International Jury will be final in accordance with RRS 70.5.
- 1.2 RRS Appendix P will apply
- 1.3 The prescriptions of the national authority, HSF, will not apply.
- 1.4 RRS 32 will be changed to provide that courses will not be shortened.
- 1.5 RRS 33b will not apply.
- 1.6 RRS 35 will be changed to provide that boats not finishing within 60 minutes after the first boat to finish will be scored "Did Not Finish" without a hearing.
- 1.7 RRS 62.2 and 66 will be changed to shorten the time for requesting redress and the requesting that a hearing be reopened on the last day of racing.
- 1.8 RRS A4.1 will be changed to provide that a boat failing to check in prior to the warning signal will be scored the same as a boat not starting in that race without a hearing.

2. Advertising

- 2.1 The ISAF Advertising Regulation 20 will apply.
- 2.2 Boats may be required to display a bow number and advertisement of the event sponsor on either side on the forward 25% of the hull.
- 2.3 Boats authorized to have advertising must present their permission of their National Authority.

3. Eligibility and Entry

- 3.1 Entries eligible in accordance with STCR 21, 26, 29 and 30 may compete.
- 3.2 Entries shall be submitted on the Official Online Entry Form not later than 20th of February to the Hellenic Sailing Federation.
- 3.3 Only skippers and crew eligible to compete under the ISAF Eligibility Code shall be eligible to compete in this regatta.
- 3.4 For the purpose of RRS A Scoring: A competitor is not considered an entry until: (a) All fees are paid and (b) Measurement check is completed.

4. Fees

The entry fee of 120€ includes boat and trailer parking and invitations to social events for skipper and crew.

5. Schedule

- 5.3 Schedule of Races

- 5.4 The schedule time of the warning signal for the first race each day is 11:00.

6. Measurement

- 6.1 Each participating boat shall have a valid Measurement Certificate in his/her name. Only boats that have completed registration, paid all entry fees, and passed the weighing control are entitled to race. The International Jury may order that a boat be re-checked during the regatta.
- 6.2 Crews shall demonstrate compliance with crew weight limits in accordance with STCR 31.1.3 prior to 10:00 on March 21st. Crews may be re-weighed during the event at the discretion of the Organizing Authority.
- 6.3 Each boat shall display the sail number and national letters as indicated on the Official Entry Form.

7. Sailing Instructions

The Sailing Instructions will be available upon registration.

8. Venue

Racing will be conducted at Faliron Bay.

9. Courses

Courses will be according to STCR 34.

10. Scoring

The Low Point Scoring System, RRS A, will apply, modified so that each series score will be the total of her races scores with her worst score excluded if more than four (4) races are completed.

11. Team and Private Support Boats

A yacht shall receive no outside assistance from support boats or otherwise once she has left the dock for the day until the finish of the last race of the day, except in the case of emergency and/or towing supplied by the organizer and available to all participants.

14. Prizes

14.1 Perpetual Trophies will be awarded according to STCR 24.

14.2 Series prizes will be awarded to the skipper and crew finishing first through third place.

15. Disclaimer

The Organizing Authority will require each competitor to sign a waiver for loss, damage or injury to persons or property occurring in conjunction with the regatta or on the property of the Hellenic Sailing Federation. The Organizing Authority, their members, employees, officers and/or agents shall not be responsible for any loss, damage or injury that may occur to person or property whether ashore or at sea as a consequence of the participation of any boat.

16. Insurance

Proof of marine liability insurance (property and injury) in the amount of 540.000€ covering the person in charge (RRS 46) during this regatta is required.
