**Question:**

1. SI addendum FS 2.3. Could you please explain the last sentence.

**Answers:**

FS2.3 reads:

Races not sailed on the scheduled day may be sailed on a following day, except that no more than 3 races of the Opening Series shall be sailed on any day, including sailing an opening series race on the provisional medal race/final race day. If the provisional medal final race day is used for extending the opening series, the medal race and final race shall be cancelled. A race that the first boat has completed 3 legs before being abandoned, shall count as a scheduled race for the purpose of this SI, but shall not be scored.

The last sentence has been amended in SI Amendment #2 to read:

‘A race that the first boat has completed 3 legs (except any offset leg between marks 1 and 1A) before being abandoned, shall count as a scheduled race for the purpose of this SI, but shall not be scored.’

The last sentence means that, for example, if 2 races have been completed and the third race is abandoned after the first boat has completed 3 legs, there cannot be another race that day.

The abandoned race will not be scored.
